The Indian Education Program is funded by the Title VI Grant. We need your help by filling out the 506 form and sending it back to our office. The collection of these forms determine the amount of funding our program receives. This funding allows us to provide services and cultural opportunities for our students and families. All information is kept confidential.

Title VI requires:

1. Student is enrolled in a federally recognized tribe
2. And/or the student's grandparent or parent is enrolled in a federally recognized tribe. It is not mandatory for all students to utilize our program services however, by filling out an eligibility form, the whole program benefits.

This allows us to provide services in all of these areas: Mentor Program, School Supplies, Advocating for students and families, Cultural Activities, Native American Clubs, and College and Career Readiness activities.
